

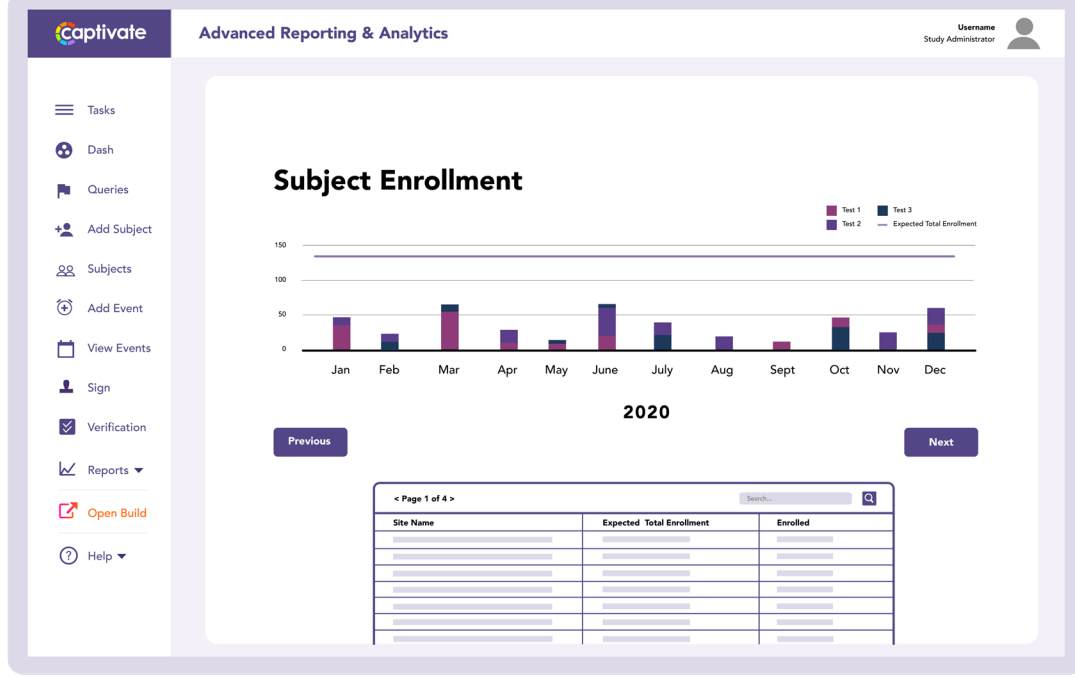

Study Progress

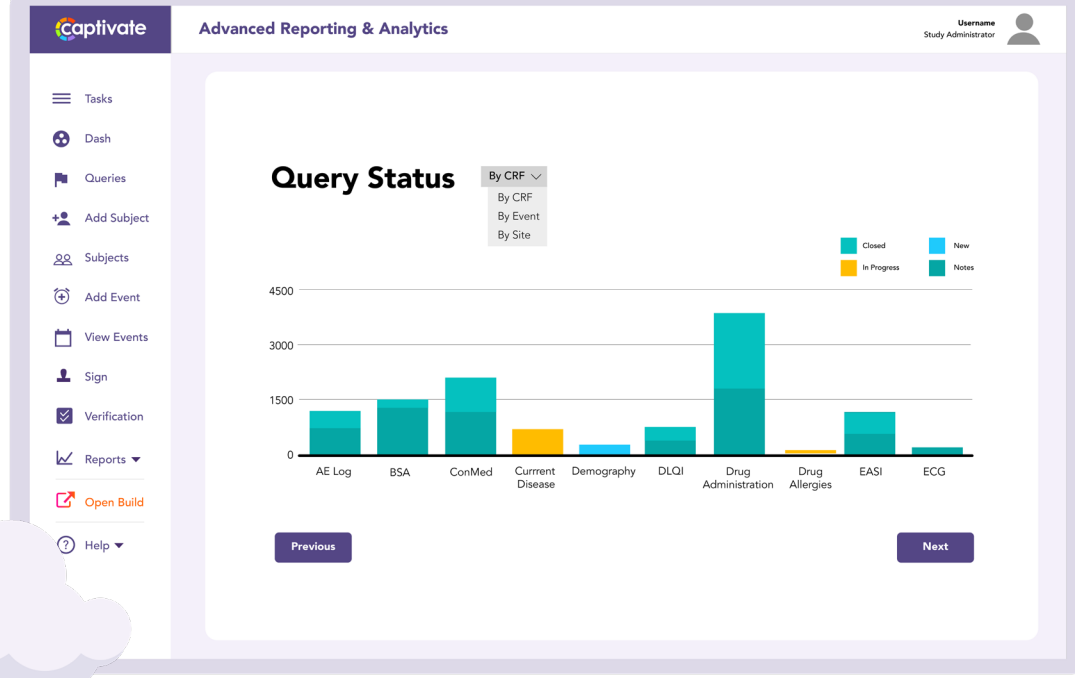
The Subject Enrollment

and actual trend lines on a graph. This report is used by study teams to show a high-level overview of subject enrollment trends throughout the course of the study.



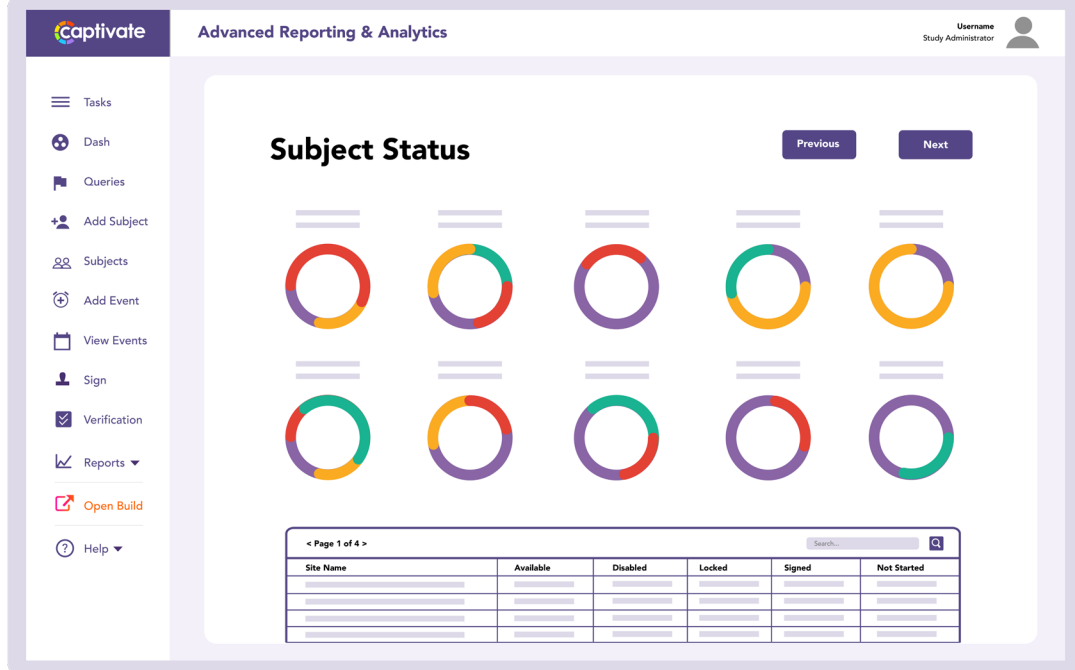
Query Status Report

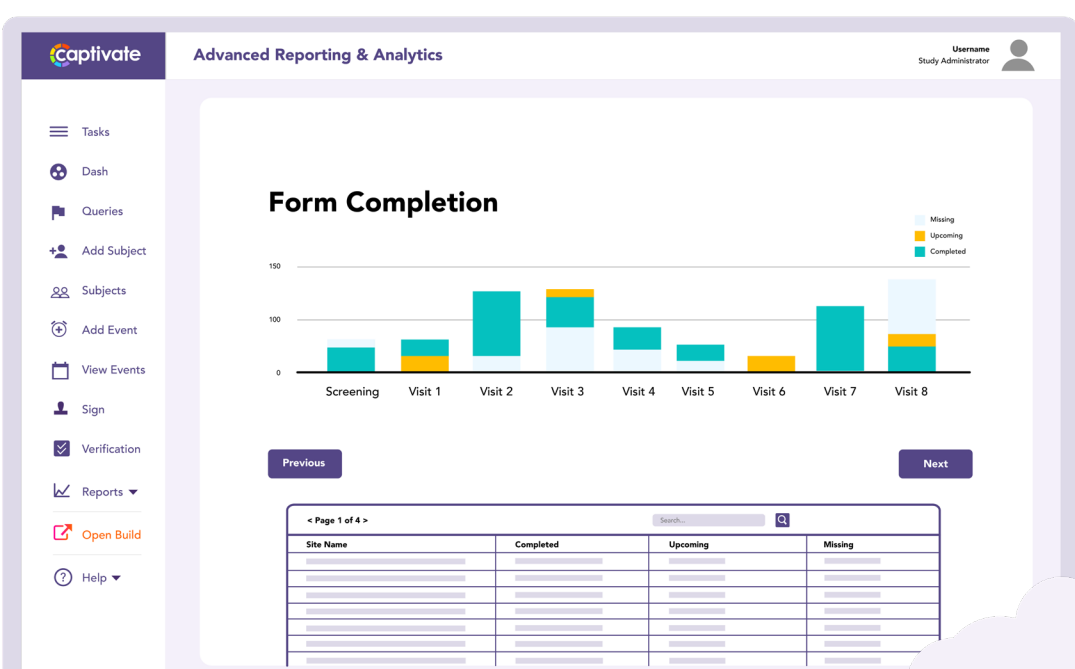
Subject Status

Form Completion

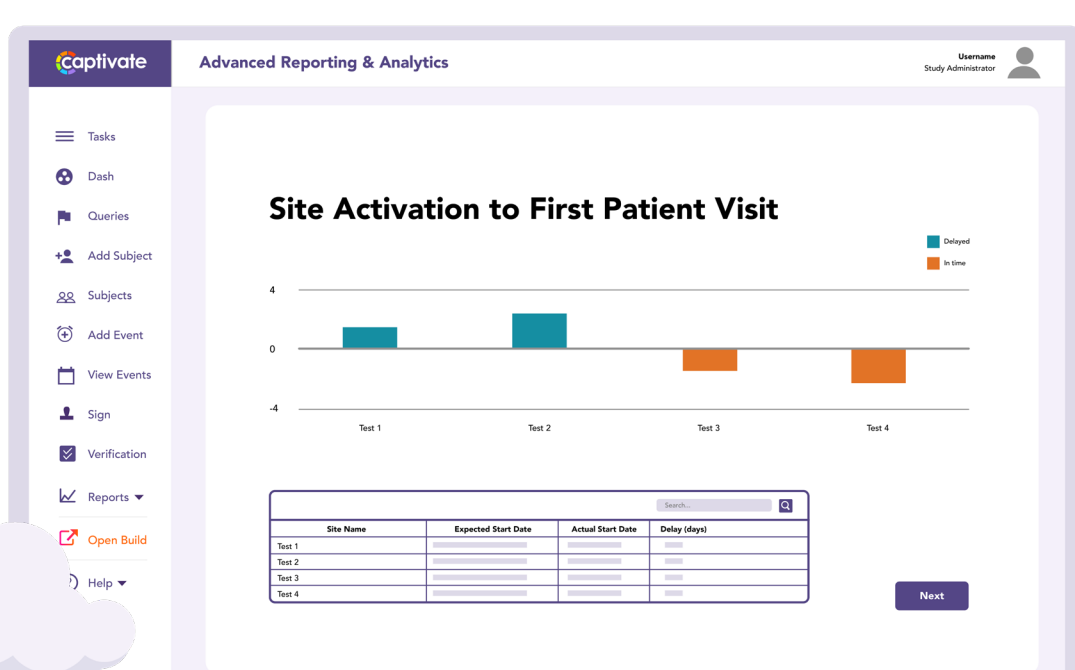
